Tuesday 7 November

Auckland to London

Please make your own way to Auckland International Airport. On arrival, please check in with Air New Zealand. We recommend you arrive three hours before your flight is scheduled to depart.

Our flight gets into London at **TBC**. After arriving in London we will transfer for the final leg of our journey and board a flight to Paris. We will arrive in the French capital at **TBC**.

The All Blacks first played against Scotland in 1905 at [Inverleith] in Edinburgh. The two teams have played 30 times, with New Zealand winning 28 matches and 2 resulting in draws. The most recent Test was played at Murrayfield on 15 November 2014, with New Zealand winning 24-16.

Tonight we will enjoy a group function and dinner at the famous Edinburgh Castle where we'll experience some fantastic Scottish entertainment, plus a private viewing of the ancient Honours of Scotland - the crown, sceptre and sword of state (the Scottish Crown Jewels) - in the Crown Room of the castle.
